Subject: Implementation of the Carrier Appointment System (CAS) at Nellis AFB for FB4852, FV4852 for Delivery Appointments

Purpose: To advise Transportation Service Providers (TSP) on the use of the CAS, detail the delivery appointments that are now available, and provide the rules for using each appointment type.

Be Advised: On 15 Jan 2013, Nellis Air Force Base (AFB) will begin using the CAS to manage incoming deliveries. The following appointment types are accepted at Nellis AFB:

1. AA&E & FAK deliveries to 5045 Minot Ave. Bldg. 10301, must be made utilizing CAS. Currently, Nellis AFB does not accept same-day deliveries in CAS. TSPs who need to make same day delivery appointments should schedule the appointment using the first available date and time slot in CAS (typically, this will be on the next business day). TSPs will call Nellis AFB directly to have the appointment rescheduled for a same-day delivery.

2. Nellis AFB does not provide Secure Holding.

3. AA&E receiving hours are 0800-1400 Monday-Thursday and 0800-1100 on Friday.

4. If you do not have access to CAS, TSPs must call the Deployments and Distribution flight receiving section to schedule an appointment.
