MEMORANDUM FOR Mr. William Lindquist, Universal Services Contract 7 (USC-7)
Contracting Officer, Directorate of Acquisition (TCAQ-D), USTRANSCOM

SUBJECT: Designation of Exigency Areas for USC-7

1. In accordance with USC-7, Paragraph 6.A, I hereby designate Afghanistan, Pakistan, Iraq and Libya as Exigency Areas beginning with the base period of performance on 1 October 2012.
2. This designation and all contractual clauses governing Exigency Areas will remain in effect for these countries until the designation is rescinded.
3. Based on the current operational environment and the data available to us, it is likely that a substantial number of commercial containers transiting or consigned to locations in these countries will not be returned to carriers due to U.S. Government necessity.
4. Additional countries or areas meeting the Exigency Area criteria will be designated as such via separate memorandum when necessary.
