

PACIFIC THEATRE REQUIREMENTS

- 1) If training is planned in theater, please be advised of USPACOM's strict guidelines that must be completed prior to traveling in the theater. See below.
- 2) There are new PACOM requirements that are mandated and must be met prior to proceeding in theater.
- 3) All repeat all travelers to include TDY are required to complete the SERE (Survival, Evasion, Resistance, and Escape) Level B and Code of Conduct Training and Personnel Recovery (ISOPREP-DD Form 1833) report prior to traveling within the Pacific area. **This is a USPACOM requirement and must be completed within six months of arrival within the AOR.** You can access the website using your CAC and create an account using your SSAN and a password.

The SERE Level B and Code of Conduct Training take 2 to 3 hours of online viewing and testing. Individuals are required to complete this training and print their training certificate.

- 4) All travelers are required to complete the ISOPREP (Isolated Personnel Report) Card (DD Form 1833). Travelers must take 2 digital photos and upload their photos on the report website when completing the online DD Form 1833. Photos should be taken prior to completing the online report. One copy of the electronically completed form should be given to the S2 and another electronic copy to the Personnel Recovery Mission Software (PRMS) database.
- 5) Copies of the completed report form and training certificate must be provided to the unit AFTP officer for unit record purposes. Please provide this office the travelers who have completed these requirements.
- 6) Also, please note USPACOM's New Country Clearance and Travel Requirements.
- 7) Individual travelers will be required to complete the following tasks prior to travel:
 - Obtain a Country Threat Briefing
 - Submit a Country/Theater clearance request (Message)
 - Completed AT Level 1 Training once a year (online) (state in the travel orders)
 - Completed SERE Training and Isolated Personnel Recovery (ISOPREP) report once a year (online) (state in travel orders)

-Prepare and submit an approved Individual Force Protection (FP) Plan (Sign by the Commander)

-Travel to the Republic of Korea requires country-specific mandatory training required for all military, civilian and contractors TDY to Korea. This is a 4-hour online training. Travel clearance message must indicate date of completed country specific training to Korea.

8) Travel into the Pacific is very stringent and restrictive due to security issues and concerns.
